

## **2022 NC Black Elected Municipal Officials Scholarship Guidelines Minimum Eligibility Requirements (Applicants)**

1. Each year the NC Black Elected Municipal Officials, through generous donations, is able to provide scholarships to outstanding students who live in NC and will attend a university/college in the NC System or out of state. The awards are \$1,000.00 for students attending a (four year) college or University and (\$500.00) for students attending a Technical School. It is the duty of our dedicated Scholarship Committee to determine the most outstanding individuals to receive these awards. The NC Black Elected Municipal Officials do not provide financial aid to individuals, only scholarships through this process.
2. Must be a U.S. Citizen and a resident of North Carolina.
3. Applicant must submit an official high school transcript on official school letterhead (school stamped) and or signed, with two letters of recommendations from teachers or other professionals written on their letterhead.
4. Applicant must provide evidence of acceptance/enrollment in a four-year university/college or a two-year college or technical school by providing a copy of an official acceptance letter.
5. Applicant must have a grade point average at or above 3.0 (B)
6. Applicant must provide a list of awards, volunteer and work hours with the year received attached.
7. Applicant must complete the scholarship application with all required documents.  
Please gather and submit all required documentation at the same time and in Word or PDF format.
8. Scholarship application should meet the June 24, 2022 DEADLINE.
9. Presentation of scholarships will take place in Beaufort, NC on August 1. Recipient is required to be present to receive the scholarship.

10. Application and all correspondence must be typed. Incomplete applications will lose points
